The role supports, rather than leads, institutional industry and international engagement by facilitating academically aligned activities where appropriate.

Purpose of the Role

To coordinate and support academic engagement initiatives that strengthen Belgium Campus iTiversity's teaching, learning, research and student development objectives while promoting educational outreach, digital literacy and innovation in alignment with the institution's strategic priorities.

Key Responsibilities

Academic Engagement Coordination

- Coordinate institution-wide academic engagement initiatives that support teaching, learning, research and student development.
- Facilitate opportunities for academic staff and students to engage with schools, communities and external stakeholders through academically aligned activities.
- Promote the integration of academic engagement into curricula, projects and institutional initiatives.

Schools Engagement & Learner Development

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- Coordinate academic enrichment initiatives that introduce school learners to Information Technology, Computing and Digital Innovation.
- Support coding programmes, STEM initiatives, learner workshops, competitions and technology awareness activities.
- Work collaboratively with Marketing and Student Recruitment to support learner engagement initiatives while ensuring the academic integrity of all outreach activities.

Student Engagement & Experiential Learning

- Coordinate academically recognised engagement opportunities that enhance student learning, leadership and graduate readiness.
- Support service-learning, project-based learning, mentoring and experiential learning initiatives where appropriate.
- Assist academic departments in embedding engagement activities into the student learning experience.

Academic Outreach & Knowledge Sharing

- Coordinate public lectures, seminars, research showcases, coding academies, innovation challenges and other academic outreach initiatives.
- Promote the dissemination of knowledge through activities that showcase Belgium Campus iTversity's academic expertise and research.
- Support initiatives that promote digital literacy, technology awareness and lifelong learning.

Institutional Academic Initiatives

- Provide coordination and operational support for academic initiatives led by the Dean: Postgraduate Studies & Research.
- Support the planning and delivery of research colloquia, postgraduate events, academic conferences and institutional academic projects.
- Coordinate cross-functional academic engagement activities involving faculties and institutional support divisions.

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- Support the implementation of the institution's academic engagement strategy and contribute to initiatives that strengthen Belgium Campus iTiversity's research culture, postgraduate environment and academic reputation.

Stakeholder Coordination

- Coordinate engagement with schools, academic partners, community organisations and other stakeholders in support of approved academic initiatives.
- Facilitate communication and collaboration between internal and external stakeholders while ensuring alignment with institutional priorities.
- Refer and coordinate opportunities relating to industry partnerships, international collaboration and strategic institutional agreements with the relevant institutional offices, while supporting implementation where academic engagement is required.

Planning, Reporting & Continuous Improvement

- Maintain accurate records of academic engagement activities, participation and institutional outcomes.
- Prepare reports, dashboards and impact summaries to support institutional planning and quality assurance.
- Monitor emerging trends and identify opportunities to strengthen academic engagement across the institution.
- Contribute to the continuous improvement of academic engagement policies, processes and initiatives.

Minimum Qualifications & Experience

Minimum Requirements:

- A relevant Bachelor's degree (NQF Level 7) is required. A relevant postgraduate qualification (NQF Level 8 or higher) will be strongly advantageous.

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- Three to five years' relevant experience within higher education, community engagement, stakeholder management, outreach coordination or project management.
- Demonstrated experience coordinating projects or initiatives involving multiple stakeholders.
- Strong organisational, communication and administrative coordination skills.
- Ability to work effectively across academic, community and student-facing environments.

Desired Experience and Knowledge:

- Postgraduate qualification (NQF Level 8 or above).
- Experience within higher education, youth development, innovation ecosystems or ICT-related environments.
- Exposure to hackathons, coding initiatives, digital inclusion programmes or innovation-focused outreach activities.
- Experience engaging with schools, NGOs, public sector organisations or community-based initiatives.
- Familiarity with student development and experiential learning initiatives.
- Experience coordinating academic events, outreach initiatives or student engagement programmes within a higher education environment.
